
Scripture Outline & Reflection

Today's Readings

Deuteronomy 18:15 - 20; Psalm 95:1-2, 6-7, 7-9

1 Corinthians 7:32-35; Mark 1:21-28

Jesus came as one who spoke in the name of the Lord (1), teaching with authority (3). Let us listen to his voice (Ps) and adhere to him above anything else (2).


