Saint Jerome Emiliani, Priest

Feast Day February 8th - Patron Saint of Orphans and Abandoned Children

He was forever grateful after surviving an encounter with death

Saint Jerome Emiliani was a soldier in the city state of Venice and was appointed the commander of a fortress. In a battle against a league of city states, the fortress fell and Jerome was imprisoned. A heavy chain was wrapped around his neck, hands, and feet, and fastened to a huge chunk of marble in an underground prison. He was forgotten, alone, and treated like an animal in the gloom of a dungeon. He repented of his godless life. He prayed. He dedicated himself to the Madonna. And then, somehow, he escaped, chains in hand, and fled to a nearby city. He walked through the doors of the local church and headed to the front to fulfill a fresh vow. He slowly approached a much venerated Virgin and placed his chains on the altar before her. He knelt, bowed his head, and prayed. His life was about to begin again. Saint Jerome was canonized in 1767 and named the Patron Saint of orphans and abandoned children in 1928.


READINGS
