

SAINT VALENTINE

Feast Day - February 14th

Patron Saint of lovers, the betrothed, epileptics and happy marriages

The ancient Roman Martyrology, the compendium of martyrs at Rome, list two 3rd-century martyrs named Valentine for this day, and they can probably be identified as the same person. One was a priest in Rome, the other a bishop of Terni. The first healed the daughter of a prefect and converted the entire family to Christianity; the second is known for his gifts at miracle-working. Victims of anti-Christian persecutions, both were martyred and buried in Rome. The depiction of this saint in art reflects this double history, for he can appear dressed as a bishop or a priest. His attributes are the pastoral staff, the palm, or an epileptic child. He is invoked against stomach pains.

THE SEVEN SERVITE FOUNDERS (CONFESSORS)

Feast Day - February 17th

Protectors of those who plan something good together

Their names were Buonfiglio, a name of favorable auspices; Buonagiunta means "blessed"; Bartholomew means "loves God"; Geraldino means "brave"; Ricovero means "heart, spirit"; Alexis means "defender". Devout Florentines, they formed an order devoted to the Virgin Mary. In 1245, they set off from Florence to live a life of fraternity, penitence, and contemplation while caring for the poor. The order of friars they founded, known as the Servants of the Blessed Virgin Mary, or Servites, followed the rule of Saint Augustine. They were canonized in 1888. They are usually depicted together in adoration the Virgin, wearing the black habit of their order.


