**Reborn in Confession**

Annie grew up on the streets of Brooklyn. She had a colorful past and an outrageous sense of humor. She came to us in a crisis pregnancy, and we supported her as she chose life. One afternoon, as we chatted about birthdays, she asked my age. I dodged the question, explaining how G. K. Chesterton would base his age on the last time he went to confession, so he might be just a day or a week old. Annie shared that she hadn't been to confession since she was a little girl. Much had happened since then. She was moved to learn we are reborn in confession. Breaking the silence, she said, "Sister, I was born at night, but it wasn't last night. Now dish it. How old are you?"

In Christ's parable of the prodigal son, there is a celebration when the son returns: music, dancing, a feast. Because one who was dead is now alive, and the lost one has been found.

Annie called a few days later to discuss plans for the baby's birth. As we were about to hang up, she said, "By the way, Sister, I am six hours old. I went to confession today for the first time in decades." At her next visit to the convent we had a great celebration, because the one who was dead came back to life.
