Feast of St. Joseph - May 1st

The feast of Saint Joseph, putative father of Jesus, is celebrated on March 19, but in 1955 Pope Pius XII inserted this memorial to Joseph's a worker in the liturgical calendar. To emphasize the dignity of human labor, the Christian ideals of work, and the example of Joseph as a worker, he made the day coincide with May Day, the day on which much of the world celebrates labor. The Second Vatican Council explicated this, saying that "workers continue the work of the Creator and make themselves useful to their brethren."



Joseph is depicted as an elderly man with a flowering staff and carpenter's tools. The name Joseph is from the Hebrew and means "he will add."

Saint Joseph the Worker, inspire all laborers of mind or body to work for their daily bread as much as your glorification. May our work be done well to perfect us and to make us participants in completing the creation God began in Genesis.
