

SAINT JOAN OF ARC  
FEAST DAY - MAY 30TH

Joan was born at Domremy, France, around 1412. An illiterate peasant, from the age of thirteen she heard the voices of saints calling on her to free France, at the time involved in the Hundred Years War (1339-1453). She thus went into battle against the army of the English, for on the basis of holdings on French soil the

English claimed rights to the throne. In fact, Joan succeeded in having Charles VIII crowned at Rheims. Betrayed and tried as a heretic, Joan was sent to the pyre in 1431. Pope Calixtus III ordered the trial annulled in 1455; Joan was fully rehabilitated and finally canonized in 1920. She is depicted in armor bearing a standard.
