

**SAINT ROMUALD
FEAST DAY - JUNE 19TH**

Born around 950 at Ravenna, Italy, he chose the religious life becoming a Benedictine monk. He felt a strong need to join eremitical experience to that of the monastic community; he achieved his goal in the founding of the monastery at Camaldoli in 1012, which he gave a new rule, stricter than the Benedictine. He died in the Castro valley in 1027 and was canonized in 1595. He is depicted with a long beard, wearing the white cloak of the reformed Benedictines. His attributes are the Bible, the tempting devil, and a ladder he saw in a dream on which monks climbed to the sky.


