**SAINT CYRIL OF ALEXANDRIA
FEAST DAY - JUNE 27TH**

Born at Alexandria, Egypt, between 370 and 380, Cyril lived as a hermit until a patriarch uncle convinced him to return to the religious community. In 412, he became in turn patriarch of Alexandria, in which post he demonstrated unwavering authority, battling heresies, in particular the Nestorian, which brought him into doctrinal conflict with Nestorius, patriarch of Constantinople. Among the leading theologians and exegetes of the East, Cyril, nicknamed "seal of the Father," died in 444. He is depicted in episcopal vestments.

Patron: Cyril is the patron saint of Alexandria, Egypt.

Name: Cyril is from the Persian and means, "young king"
