Henry was born in Bavaria in 973 and was crowned Holy Roman Emperor in 1014. Feeling responsible for his subjects in terms of their faith, he has a strong influence on Church matters and favored the spread of monasticism. He died in 1024. He was buried in the cathedral of Bamberg, which he has founded, and was canonized in 1146. He is depicted in imperial robes.
