Of noble origins, Daniel was born into the tribe of Judah. In 605 B.C., when he was still very young, he was deported to Babylon following the first destruction of Jerusalem. Along with other aristocrats he served as a page at the court of Nebuchadnezzar. Educated in the Babylonian culture, he distinguished himself as an interpreter of dreams, thanks to which he reached high levels. He always remains faithful to the Jewish religion, thus making many enemies and risking death. He is depicted as a young prophet bearing a scroll or book, sometimes surrounded by lions protecting Susanna.
