

**SAINT NICODEMUS
FEAST DAY - AUGUST 3RD**

Nicodemus is cited in the Gospel of John; member of the Sanhedrin, he prohibited the arrest of Jesus, opposing the other Pharisees, and after the crucifixion he helped Saint Joseph of Arimathea bury Jesus. Tradition holds that he was baptized by the apostles Peter and John and that he was martyred together with Stephen. The commemoration falls on the day of the translation of his relics. He is depicted among the figures in scenes of the Deposition (Decent from the cross).

Name: Nicodemus is of Greek origin and means "winner among the people."






Galatians 5:22-23
