

**SAINT CLARE OF ASSISI
FEAST DAY - AUGUST 11TH**

Clare was born of a noble family in Assisi, Italy, in 1194. Deeply moved by the acts of Francis Assisi, she decided to follow his example. She founded the order of the Poor Clares, giving it a rule that was approved in 1228 by Pope Gregory IX and was confirmed by Innocent IV in 1253, the year of Clare's death. She was canonized in 1255. Clare is depicted in the black-and-brown habit of her order, with the lily, cross, and sometimes the staff of an abbess. Her attribute is a monstrance.



Protector: Television, embroiderers, launderers, guilders, ironer, and the blind.

Name: Clare is the Latin origin and means "clear, luminous."


