

**THE SEVEN SORROWS OF MARY
FEAST DAY - SEPTEMBER 15TH**

Devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows became a standard devotion in the Church around the 14th century. It was revealed to St. Bridget of Sweden (1303-1373) that devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary's Seven Sorrows would bring great signal graces. The devotion consists in praying seven Hail Mary's while meditating on the Seven Sorrows of Mary. The feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is September 15th.



The Seven Sorrows devotion involves praying seven Hail Marys a day, each one while meditating on one of Our Lady's seven sorrows, which are:

- The prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:34-35).
- The flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-21).
- The loss of the Child Jesus in the temple (Luke 2:41-50).
- The meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross (John 19:17).
- The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (John 19:18-30).
- The taking down of the Body of Jesus from the Cross and preparation for burial (John 19:39-40).
- The burial of Jesus (John 19:39-42).
