Call the rectory in case of emergency.



TEMPTATION IN THE DESERT

In the first Sunday of Lent, we see Jesus led by the Spirit into the desert to be tempted by the devil. The setting of the desert, an inhospitable place that stands in complete contrast to Eden, is very eloquent. A passage in the Old Testament seems to point to a Jewish belief in a malevolent spirit called Azazel who dwelled in the desert (cf. *Lev 16:10* and *Tob 8:3*). Jesus thus was led into the dwelling place of the tempter. Moreover, the desert was the place where the chosen people underwent their trial. Our Lord comes to defeat the devil where the people of Israel fell.



All of us in one way or another confront every day these trials of the desert. Benedict XVI wrote: "at the heart of all temptations, as we see here, is the act of pushing God aside because we perceive him as secondary, if not actually superfluous and annoying. Being in a hurry, the eagerness for human effectiveness, and daily difficulties can all lead us to neglect and even to reject our relationship with God; or to expect from Him a striking intervention that causes us to react. But when we put God's will first in our life, He sooner or later raises us up.

Matthew says that, after Jesus conquered every temptation "angels came and ministered to him." Saint Josemaria remarked: "the Church reminds us that during Lent, when we recognize our sins, our wretchedness and our need for purification, there is also room for joy. Lent is a time for both bravery and joy; we have to fill ourselves with courage, for the grace of God will not fail us. God will be at our side and will send his angels to be our traveling companions, our prudent advisers along the way, our cooperators in all that we take on.
