Whether you have been to confession recently or perhaps it has been many years, now is the time to know that His heart is open and eager to forgive.

We Are All Lazarus

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent, we find ourselves in Bethany. The great drama unfolds as Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead. Truth be told, Lazarus' tomb can now be found in every parish church throughout the world: the confessional.

You and I, dead because of our sins, tied up by our weaknesses, decayed and odorous by our pride, kneel before a screen and pour out our hearts. Then the conversation between Jesus and Martha is renewed, encouraging us toward a deeper faith and a stronger purpose of amendment.

Lord, if you had been here. The plea may seem to be in vain. But he is always here, waiting, patiently, for the next one to enter the tomb of the confessional.

Jesus is never too late. With a voice filled with compassion and hope, he commands: *Come out, untie him, or, equally powerful and awesome: "I absolve you from your sins..."*

Lazarus doesn't speak, he is overcome with amazement. He was in the deep darkness of sin, despair, and death, but now he basks in the light of Christ's merciful love.

Yes, the tomb in today's Gospel is right here in our midst and Christ is waiting, because we are all Lazarus.
