Call the rectory in case of emergency.



New Mausoleum

Is it fair to your loved ones to put off buying a burial place? Should you get one place or two - or maybe three? Should you get vaults in the ground, build a tomb, or buy in the mausoleum? These are questions you will have to answer one day. What would you do if something happened in your family tomorrow? It is human nature to avoid this subject since we do not like to think about it, much less discuss it, but death is inevitable. Securing burial places ahead of time is good family planning and makes good practical sense, especially now while the church is offering a mausoleum program with available financing. You have choices: there are four different types of crypts available on four different levels, and the moment you sign up, you will be covered. The main thing is that you have the opportunity to willfully do this now as a means of preparing for your future, rather than being forced into it later because something happened! You owe it to yourself and your loved ones to at least get the information from one of the representatives while they are here, and then the decision will be yours. Call the Administration Office at 504-324-1119 to leave your name and phone number and a mausoleum representative will then be in touch with you.
