

Saint Veronica Giuliani
Feast Day - July 9th

Born in 1660 at Urbino, Italy, and baptized as Ursula, she took the name Veronica when she entered the convent of Capuchin nuns at Citta di Castello in Umbria, at the age of seventeen. She was a great mystic, and on the orders of her spiritual director, she diligently transcribed her numerous revelations for thirty years in a diary that was published much later, entitled *Diary of the Passion*. She received the stigmata and died in 1727. She is depicted with the robes of the Clares in adoration of the crucifix with the crown of thorns and the instruments of the Passion. She went to her eternal reward in 1727 after spending 50 years in the covenant. The saint's body remained incorrupt for many years until it was destroyed in a flood. Her bones are now kept in a composite figure of the saint, the skull of which is covered with wax. Her heart, though, is still incorrupt, and is kept in a separate reliquary. Because of her heroic virtues and the many miracles that were continually being worked at her tomb, she was canonized by Pope Gregory XVI in 1839.


