**Birth of the Blessed Virgin Mary
Feast Day September 8**

Joachim and Anna lived chastely without any children for about twenty years, in the favor of God and the esteem of men. And Anna brought forth, and inquiring of the midwife, she was told it was a girl, and she said: "My soul has been magnified this day," and she laid her child down. The days having been fulfilled, Anna was purified, and gave the breast to the child and called her name Mary. In Mary's soul from the very beginning was the bliss of heaven; in the first instant of her conception, Mary, by a singular grace and privilege granted by God, was preserved exempt from all original sin.
