



**Saint Pius of Pietreclina  
Feast Day September 23rd**

Francesco Forgione was born at Pietreclina, northeast of Naples, in 1887. He became a Capuchin in 1903, choosing to call himself Pius (Far Pio: he is famous Padre Pio). Ordained priest in 1910, in 1916 he was transferred to the convent of San Giovanni Coronado, where he spent the rest of his life. He was active in caring for the needy and revealed gifts as a miracle worker. He received the stigmata in 1918, sign of communion with the Passion of Christ. He died in 1968 and was canonized in 2002. He is depicted in the habit of a Capuchin friar.



**Questions about the Scriptures used during Mass**

**Do we read from the Bible at mass?**

Readings from Scripture are part of every Mass. At least two readings, one always from the Gospels, (3 on Sundays and solemnities) make up the Liturgy of the Word. In addition, a psalm or canticle is sung.

These readings are typically read from a Lectionary, not a Bible, though the Lectionary is taken from the Bible.
