


**Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe  
Last Sunday in Ordinary Time**

"Though already present in his Church, Christ's reign is nevertheless yet to be fulfilled "with power and great glory" by the King's return to earth. This reign is still under attack by the evil powers, even though they have been defeated definitively by Christ's Passover. Until everything is subject to him, 'until there be realized new heavens and a new earth in which justice dwells, the pilgrim Church, in her sacraments and institutions, which belong to this present age, carries the mark of this world which will pass, and she herself takes her place among the creatures which groan and travail yet and await the revelation of the sons of God.' That is why Christians pray, above all in the Eucharist, to hasten Christ's return by saying to him: *Marana tha!* 'Our Lord, come!'" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church, 671*)

The **Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe**, formerly referred to as "Christ the King," was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist. The feast is intended to proclaim in a striking and effective manner Christ's royalty over individuals, families, society, governments, and nations.


**Ministry to the Sick and Shut In:**

**Saint of the Week!**  
**Saint Cathrine of Alexandria**



Cathrine lived between the 3rd and 4th centuries. Probably of noble lineage, she refused to marry Massimino Daia, governor of Egypt and Syria, because she had given herself to Christ. She protested against the persecutors ordered by Emperor Maxentius and for this reason was first tortured with a toothed wheel of torture (known as "Catherines wheel") and then beheaded, (305 - 306). According to legend, Milk gushed forth from her severed neck. St. Caterine at the time of her death was carried by angels to Mt. Sinai. St. Joan of Arc was thought to have heard her voice. She converted both the empress and guard leader. She is depicted as a young woman in regal dress, and her attributes are the wheel, the palm, the sword, and the ring of mystical matrimony. She is invoked by nursing women, ship-wreck victims, and against migraines.

**Protector.** Preachers, Orators, philosophers, notaries, tailors, stylists, spinners, librarians, caterers, young nursing mothers, and wet nurses.

**Name.** Cathrine is of greek origin and means "pure"
