

**St. Bernard of Corleone**




Son of the shoemaker Leonardo Latino Bernard was born at Corleone, Sicily, in 1605 with the name Filippo, in a habitation known in the town as the “house of the saints.” Bernard’s passion for weapons was nearly his undoing he reacted to a provocation by cutting off his adversary’s arm with a sword. To flee justice and expiate his crime, he asked for shelter in a Capuchin convent and was taken in. When he became a friar retook the name Bernard, and he also changed his life, conforming to the teaching of Christ and dedicating himself to works of charity and penitence. He died in 1667 and was canonized in 2001. He is depicted in art in a Capuchin gown in the act of penitence.




