

St. Thomas Aquinas
Feast Day - January 28th

Born at Roccasecca near Aquino (in Latium, Italy), around 1225, he was educated in the abbey of Monte Cassino, where he matured his religious calling. He became Dominican friar and studied in Paris with Albert the Great, with further studies at Cologne. His many works include the *Summa theologica*, the most systematic attempt to give a scientific, philosophical, and theological foundation to Christian doctrine. He died in 1274 and was canonized in 1323. He is depicted in Dominican robes with a sun on his chest, pen, and the dove of inspiration.
