

The solemn flotilla will embark on the mighty Mississippi for a one-time only Blessing of the River and the Great State of Louisiana! This event begins at 8:00 AM on

Wednesday, August 14, 2024 with a Votive Mass of the Holy Eucharist at the Cathedral in Baton Rouge and processes down the Mississippi River to New Orleans, arriving around 4:25 pm on August 15. The flotilla will arrive at about 4:25 PM in the French Quarter and there will be a Great Benediction on the levee at 5:15 PM in front of Jackson Square, followed by a procession into St. Louis Cathedral for a final blessing and a Solemn Mass of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary by Archbishop Gregory Aymond, D.D. The 2-day festivities will conclude with a celebration in Jackson Square at 7:30 PM. All are encouraged to “Come Down to the River” for this historic event!





**Saint of the Week!**  
**Saint Mary Magdalen**  
**Disciple-Memorial**

In Gregory the Great's interpretation, Mary Magdalen was the repentant prostitute who anointed Jesus's feet and asked him to forgive her sins, becoming his disciple. She was present at the crucifixion and was the first to witness the Resurrection. In the apocryphal tradition, she evangelized Provence and died there. From there, her cult spread throughout Europe. She is sometimes depicted in an elegant dress; sometimes she is disheveled, perhaps covered by her own long hair. Her primary attribute is the ointment jar, to be added the symbols of a penitent.



**Protector:** Gardens, perfume-makers, glove-makers, and penitent.

**Names:** Mary is from the Egyptian and means "beloved"; in the Hebrew (from Miriam), it means "lady." Magdalen is from the Hebrew and means "from Mandala"
