August 11th the 2nd collection is for **Catholic Relief Services**. Let's be reminded.





Come Down the River!



The solemn flotilla will embark on the mighty Mississippi for a one-time only Blessing of the River and the Great State of Louisiana! This event begins at 8:00 AM on Wednesday, August 14, 2024 with a Votive Mass of the Holy Eucharist at the

Cathedral in Baton Rouge and processes down the Mississippi River to New Orleans, arriving around 4:25 pm on August 15. The flotilla will arrive at about 4:25 PM in the French Quarter and there will be a Great Benediction on the levee at 5:15 PM in front of Jackson Square, followed by a procession into St. Louis Cathedral for a final blessing and a Solemn Mass of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary by Archbishop Gregory Aymond, D.D. The 2-day festivities will conclude with a celebration in Jackson Square at 7:30 PM. All are encouraged to "Come Down to the River" for this historic event! 

ST. MARTHA
July 29th

Sister of Lazarus and Mary (traditionally identified as Mary Magdalen), Martha was a disciple of Jesus, who visited her several times in her home in Bethany. The Gospels refer to her three times: the episodes of raising life of Lazarus; when she complained that Mary, intent on listening to words of Jesus, was not helping with the domestic chores; and just before the Passion, when she and Mary entertained Jesus at dinner. Her cult was born in Provence with the finding of her presumed relics in 1187. She is depicted with a bucket and aspergillum or utensils for the care of the home.

Protector: Housewives, maids, servants, cooks, and hospital dietitians.

Name: Martha is from the Aramaic and means “mistress, lady”


