**TWENTY-EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:** The “Spirit of Wisdom” extolled so beautifully by Solomon in today’s first reading (Wis. 7:7-11), is not just intellectual understanding, but a whole philosophy of life. Biblically, wisdom is real insight into life, the discernment required to live life well. This Wisdom, which is a gift from God, is at the heart of human existence, so basic that “all good things” come together with her and nothing is more precious. “All gold in view of her, is a little sand.”

The rich man in St. Mark’s gospel (Mk. 10:17-30) is apparently sincere enough. When Jesus offers him the commandments as a pattern of life, the man assures him that he has been observing them since childhood. It is Jesus’ directive that he divest himself of everything that is the rich man’s stumbling block. Jesus then reminds His followers, and us, that being too caught up in possessions and wealth can distract us from the real values of a committed life. It is our attitude that is important, and for the wealthy that means a spirit of detachment from their riches, as well as a willingness to share with those in need.

To emphasize this point, our second reading from the letter to the Hebrews (Heb. 4:12-13) reminds us that nothing is hidden from God. Whatever our status or resources, each of us is responsible for what we have been given, and will one day have to render an account of our stewardship.



### **SPECIAL SAINTS’ DAYS THIS WEEK**

#### **Wednesday, October 14<sup>th</sup> – St. Callistus**

Callistus, born at the end of the first century, was a Roman slave, a convert to Christianity and eventually a pope! He established the first cemetery on the outskirts of Rome – and the catacombs that bear his name are still visited by pilgrims to the Eternal City. He was martyred in 222.

#### **Thursday, October 15<sup>th</sup> – St. Teresa of Avila**

Teresa lived in Spain in the 16<sup>th</sup> century and along with another famous mystic, St. John of the Cross, founded the reformed order of Carmelite friars and nuns. The author of several religious classics, Teresa was the first of three women to be named “Doctor of the Church”. She is also the patroness of Spain.

#### **Friday, October 16<sup>th</sup> – St. Margaret Mary**

Margaret Mary Alacoque lived in the 17<sup>th</sup> century France and spent most of her life in a convent where she lived, worked and prayed as a Visitation nun. She is remembered as a mystic whose devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus was principally responsible for the spread of that devotion to the entire Church.

#### **Saturday, October 17<sup>th</sup> – St. Ignatius of Antioch**

One of the greatest and earliest martyrs, Ignatius was bishop of Antioch when he was brought to Rome for execution and martyred there (by being thrown to wild animals) under the Emperor Trajan in the year 107. On his way to Rome he wrote seven letters (still extant) to different Churches on the Christian life and the need for faith and courage in the face of adversity.
