

Welcome Back: This weekend an old and dear friend returns from winter hibernation in Florida. Yes – Msgr. Walter Birkle is back where he belongs! He comes back to us carrying a whole new collection of stories to share with us. Msgr. Birkle will be with us until October. It is a joy to have you back, Msgr. Walter!



SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER: In today's first reading (Acts 7:55-60) we hear the story of Stephen, the Church's first martyr. Stephen was a deacon. As such he was charged with the distribution of food to the poor. But we learn from Acts that he would engage in discussions, apparently heated discussions, with certain Jews. Unable to out-argue Stephen, his enemies accused him of blasphemy, using false witnesses to further their cause. Asked if the charges were true, Stephen recounts the events of salvation history, beginning with Abraham. He concludes by accusing the Jews of opposing God by murdering Jesus. Stephen's fate is sealed when, looking upward, he declares he sees "an opening in the sky, and the Son of Man standing at God's right hand." This is indeed, blasphemy in the hearers' estimation; and Stephen pays the ultimate price, praying for his enemies with his last breath.

In our second reading (Rv. 22:12-20) St. John continues to recount his visions, today emphasizing the central place Jesus must hold in the life of all believers: Jesus is "the Alpha and the Omega," the only one who can give access to the tree of life. Today's gospel reading (Jn. 17:20-26) comes again from Jesus' words at the Last Supper. As we listen to the beautiful prayer for the unity of all believers, we can only wonder when that unity will be achieved. Until that day comes, we must never allow our differences to overshadow our shared faith in Jesus. All of us must work for the time when all will be truly one.

SPECIAL SAINTS' DAYS THIS WEEK – EASTER WEEK SEVEN

Tuesday, May 10th – St. Damien

Born in Belgium in 1840, Damien de Vuester joined a missionary order and volunteered to minister to lepers on the Hawaiian island of Molokai. He spent the rest of his life there, preaching, teaching, and showing God's love to those whom many fled. In 1885 he began a Sunday homily: "fellow lepers." Four years later he died of the disease; he was canonized in 2009.

<u>Thursday, May 12th – Sts. Neureus, Achilleus and Pancras</u>
Neureus and Achilleus were brothers who served as members of the Praetorian Guards in the Roman Army in the 2nd century. They became converts to Christianity, resigned from the army, were arrested and executed for their faith. Pancras came to Rome as a young teenager. He became friends with Christians and embraced their faith; he was martyred during the persecution of the Emperor Diocletian in the early third century. He was 14 years old.

Friday, May 13th – Our Lady of Fatima

Today we celebrate Mary who appeared to three shepherd children in Portugal in 1917. During these appearances Our Lady encouraged repentance and the praying of the Rosary. She promoted prayers for the conversion of Communist Russia.

<u>Saturday, May 14th – St. Matthias</u>
In the Acts of the Apostles (1:15-26) we read how the early Christians chose Matthias, a witness of the resurrection, to take the place of Judas and to be numbered among the apostles.
