<u>Honor Thy Father</u>: This year Father's Day fall on Sunday, June 19th. This is a day to honor all fathers – living and dead. This is a day to express our thanks for all they have done for us. It is a day to tell them how much we love them and to ask for their prayers even as we assure them

of ours. For those fathers who have gone before us into the fullness of life with God, we give thanks to God for them as we recall their memories this day. On Father's Day we begin a Triduum of Masses for those fathers whose names are enrolled with us. Special Father's Day cards and envelopes are available at the exits of the Church or in our rectory office. Envelopes can be placed in the collection basket. Let us pray that Joseph, the father of Jesus, will bless all fathers.



ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: Today we reflect on fundamental Biblical themes: God's invitation to each one of us to make a real, personal conversion to the Lord and His promise of grace to strengthen and heal us.

Our first reading (2 Sm. 12:7-10, 13) recalls the prophet Nathan's public denunciation of King David's sin – followed by his equally public announcement of God's promise of mercy and his prophecy about a coming Messiah.

St. Paul in our second reading (Gal. 2:16, 19-21) insists that our justification is God's work, not ours. In surrendering our lives to Christ and uniting our sufferings to His sacrifice on the cross, we open ourselves to His forgiving love.

Today's gospel (Luke 7:36-8:3) is a kind of summary of Our Lord's public ministry of healing. Today we are presented with a concrete, dramatic example of God's love in action as a "sinful" but penitent woman enters the house of Simon and washes Jesus feet with ointment and tears. Jesus forgives her sins and tells her: "Go in peace; your faith has saved you."

SPECIAL SAINT'S DAY THIS WEEK

Monday, June 13th - St. Anthony of Padua

St. Anthony lived in the early years of the 13th century and by his preaching, teaching and holiness of life, he had a profound impact on the Church of his own time – and on the Church in the centuries that followed. Eight centuries after his death, St. Anthony remains one of the most revered saints in the Church's calendar. (He remains the "go to" saint for everyone who has ever lost something that "must be found".)
