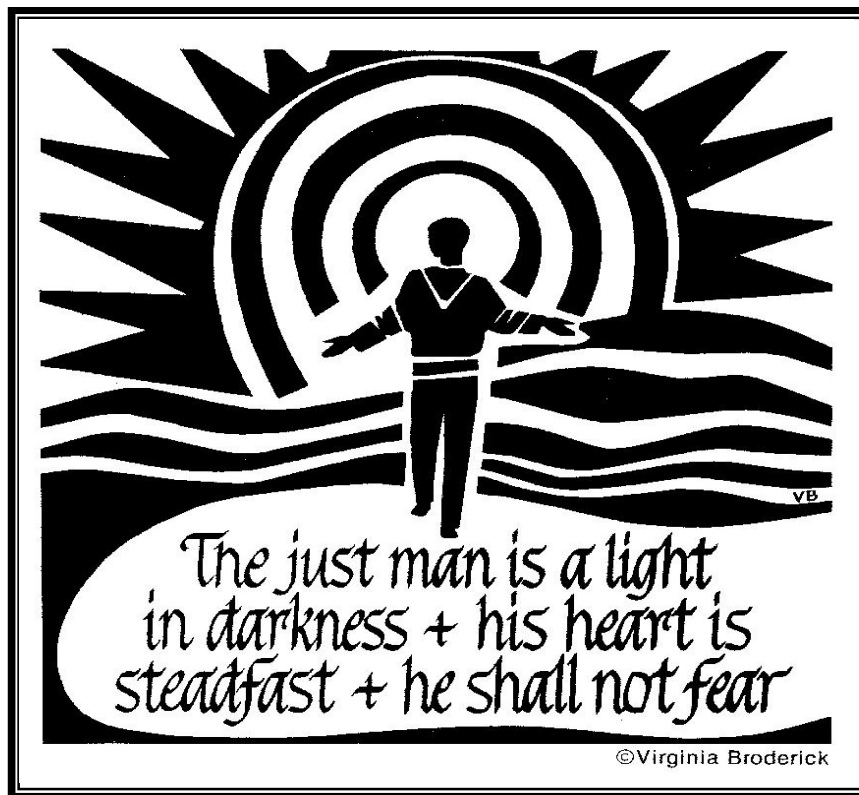

## **S.J.B. ANNOUNCEMENTS**

**February 5, 2017**

**FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME:** The Opening Prayer for today's liturgy calls upon God to *watch over the family gathered here*. It is in this gathering that we are the community, the Church that our Baptism in Christ signifies.

Our first reading from the prophet Isaiah (Is. 58:5-10) clearly states the mission of the Church: to feed the hungry; clothe the naked; shelter the homeless; to be a sign of God's Word and bring it to the light of day. The message of Paul to the Corinthians affirms human effort, but attributes its success to the power of God.

In the Gospel reading (Mt. 5:13-16) we continue to read from Our Lord's Sermon on the Mount. Today we are reminded of the mandate Jesus gave to His disciples: to be salt and light. This is a personal challenge to each and every one of us. The sharing of talents, the proliferation of good gifts, and the proclaiming of God's glory are essential in the building of the Kingdom. The earth is to be seasoned with the salt of virtue. Darkness is to be dispelled by the epiphanic light of the knowledge of God. The city is the City of God but for us that city is wherever we happen to be – wherever we can make use of our talents, wherever we can help meet the needs of God's people.

### **SPECIAL SAINTS' DAYS THIS WEEK**

#### **Monday, February 6<sup>th</sup> – St. Paul Miki and Companions**

Paul was a Japanese nobleman who lived in 16<sup>th</sup> century Japan; converted by Jesuits, he himself became a Jesuit and a successful missionary preacher in Japan. He and his companions were martyred by decree of Japan's brutal, anti-Catholic dictator.

#### **Wednesday, February 8<sup>th</sup> – St. Jerome Emiliani**

Born in Venice in 1486, Jerome was a soldier as a young man, but was increasingly drawn to a more spiritual life. He devoted himself to the care of the poor and orphaned children, eventually establishing a small religious order to continue his work.

#### **Friday, February 10<sup>th</sup> – St. Scholastica**

The twin sister of St. Benedict, the founder of Western Monasticism, Scholastica also dedicated her life to prayer and manual labor. She remained a close collaborator with her brother all her life and is the patron of Benedictine nuns.

#### **Saturday, February 11<sup>th</sup> – Our Lady of Lourdes**

On this day in 1858, is recorded the first of a series of apparitions of Our Lady to St. Bernadette near Lourdes, France. Those appearances led to the building of a beautiful basilica which has become a focus of Catholic pilgrimage and a place of miraculous healing.

**Mass Requests for 2018:** The Mass "book" for 2018 will be open for reservations as of Tuesday, February 28<sup>th</sup>. Because of the number of Parishioners who wish to arrange Masses at St. John's, we must request that Mass reservations be made in person. On February 28<sup>th</sup> those seeking to make Mass reservations should do so in the lower church (not the rectory) starting at 9:00 a.m. Someone will be there all morning and in the afternoon until 3:00 p.m. After February 28<sup>th</sup>, Mass requests for 2018 should be made in the rectory, Monday-Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Our office staff is simply unable to handle requests by phone if they are to complete the regular volume of work they have. In addition, individual Mass reservations are **limited to three on February 28<sup>th</sup>**, so we may accommodate as many parishioners as possible. **(After the initial day, more Mass reservations may be made at the rectory later in the week.)** We remind everyone that there are a number of retired priests who are able to take Mass requests – even for 2017. We are happy to provide Mass cards for these Masses; however, they will not be celebrated here at St. John's.

**Monthly Maintenance:** Since this Sunday is the first Sunday of the month of February, we will take up our regular "First Sunday of the Month" second collection after Communion this week. This collection helps with the upkeep, maintenance, and cleaning of our beautiful church. Please be generous.

**Tax Advantage:** St. John's has been contacted by a representative of H&R Block regarding a program they have for tax-exempt institutions (like ours!). For every new client who goes to any H&R Block office and has them prepare your tax returns, H&R Block will contribute \$20.00 to St. John's. The only condition is that when you go to the H&R Block office, you take a coupon (which are available this week at the exits of the Church) indicating the special code which will be given to St. John's to distribute to our parishioners. **N.B.:** This costs you nothing! Obviously, H&R Block is doing this as a promotion to bring in new customers – but if you are considering having someone prepare your tax return (both Federal and N.Y. State) this year, please consider H&R Block. They have an office nearby – on 777 Central Avenue (in the strip mall near the Sunoco station on the corner of Mile Sq. Rd. and Central Ave.) But this offer is good at any H&R Block (you just need to bring the coupon available).

**Cardinal's Appeal 2017:** Most of you know that during the months of February, March, and April we conduct the annual Archdiocesan Appeal. 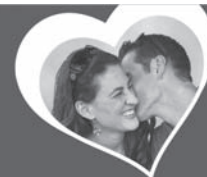
