

It is also better to purchase 2 smaller bags than one large one. This is an ongoing ministry and you may bring sugar whenever it is convenient. This food pantry serves the poor of our community. ### **A Different Look**

Once upon a time—not so very long ago—most Catholics in the United States were immigrants or the children of recent immigrants. Then a curious thing happened: Catholic immigration slowed down, and Catholics became middle-class Americans. Well, according to a recent study, "once upon a time" is back again. Hosffman Ospino, a Boston College assistant professor, served as the principal investigator for *Hispanic Ministry in Catholic Parishes*, a study of parishes serving Latino Catholics (who, incidentally, comprise forty percent of the total U.S. Catholic population). Ospino found most of these parishes serve a population dominated by immigrants. The Catholic

experience in the United States, Ospino said at a recent Boston College panel, has fundamentally changed from being a white, middle-class experience to once again being an immigrant, working-class experience, and that change has come with a set of tensions about how to respond. "What we see are thousands of parishes nationwide, and dioceses, reinventing themselves," Ospino said. His study found that twenty-five percent of Catholic parishes in the United States now have Hispanic ministries. They are intentionally creating new programs, outreach strategies, and structures to serve their new parishioners. And, increasingly, Church leaders are learning Spanish to connect with their flocks.

# OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE, THE MOTHER OF THE AMERICAS:

St. Juan Diego was a widower and lived in a small village near Mexico City. He was on his way to Mass in honor of Our Lady. He was walking by a hill called Tepeyac when he heard beautiful music. A radiant cloud appeared and within it a young Native American maiden dressed like an Aztec princess. The lady spoke to him in his own language and sent him to see the Bishop of Mexico. The Bishop was to build a chapel in the place where the lady appeared. When he went to see him, the bishop told Juan Diego to have the lady give him a sign. About the same time Juan Diego's uncle became seriously ill. He tried to avoid the lady, but she found him and assured him his uncle would recover and

provided roses for Juan to carry to the bishop in his cape. When Juan Diego opened his cape in the bishop's presence, the roses fell to the ground and the bishop sank to his knees. On Juan Diego's cape appeared an image of Mary as she had appeared at the hill of Tepeyac on December 12, 1531. The tilma with the image of Mary hangs in the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City. Since Dec. 12, 1531, nothing in the material has deteriorated. She is visited by thousands of pilgrims each year.
