Priests of the Diocese of Jackson who do not belong to religious orders are provided with a modest pension in their golden years by an endowment to which parishes pay a yearly assessment. In addition, Priests who are seniors receive a small pension supplement from the

Catholic Service Appeal. With a larger number of Priests nearing retirement age and a decline in investment returns, the endowment is not expected to keep pace with increasing costs of living. Instead of asking parishes to increase their yearly contribution to the endowment, the Diocese has opted to have a special collection for our retired Priests on Father's Day. The proceeds of this Father's Day collection will be used to increase the Diocese's pension supplement.

As we honor fathers, please consider a generous gift to assure a worthy pension/retirement for your spiritual father.
