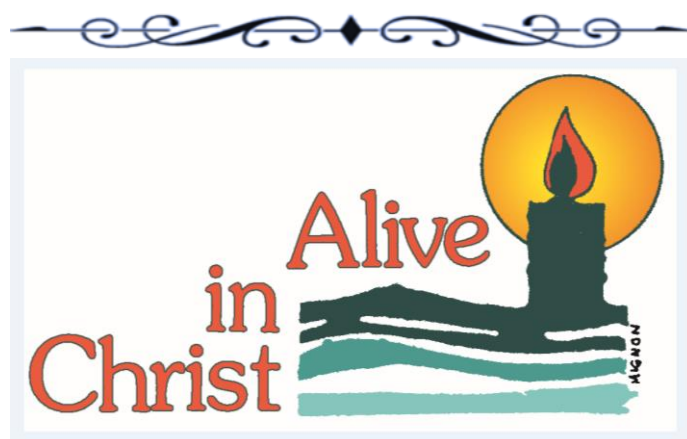


First Communion Update: with social distancing in effect we have had to make changes for the First Communion Mass:

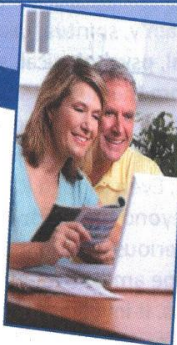

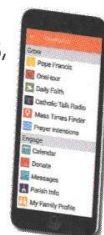
WHY IS IT
