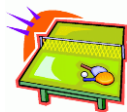
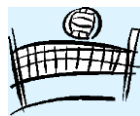

FROM OUR HOLY FATHER, POPE FRANCIS ON THE 5<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY  
OF LAUDATO SI

In May, 2021, Pope Francis and the Vatican announced a seven year plan of action to care for our common home.....the earth!

If you have been paying attention these past few years, you will recognize the words: Laudato Si. This is the name of one of the encyclicals written by our Holy Father, Pope Francis. Many of you know that we have been focusing on our Holy Father's words and

writings ever since he took office.

We began with The Joy of the Gospel. 550 of you bought the book, read it and discussed it in small groups. We followed that with the Year of Mercy, with Amoris Laetitia (the Joy of Love). We published Laudato Si paragraph by paragraph in our bulletins and held a Men's and Women's Retreat Day totally focused on the content of Laudato Si. Over 100 persons participated in that retreat. As we look at our world today, the issues have not gone away and politicians and others all over the world have begun to recognize the problems.

We have not seen the last of Laudato Si. The Vatican has announced a 7 year plan to address the many issues the Holy Father addresses in this encyclical. He is addressing his plan to the over 1.2 billion Catholics in the world to start with but all the other nations as well. The hope is that everyone from the single individual to all the organizations in the Church will somehow be involved in furthering the necessary change if we want to continue to co-create with Our Creator or continue to destroy His beautiful Creation.

If you have the courage to begin, start with watching the YouTube A PRAYER FOR THE EARTH done with voices from around the world and put together by the Jesuits. Once you have watched it, put it in the hands of someone else. Decide where you can start in your personal life and in your family.

We will continue to try to update with pertinent materials as they become available.

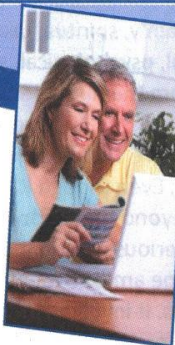

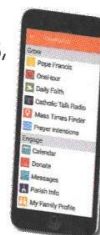
