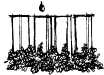

Our **scheduled** lawn cuttings ended November 6, but the grass and weeds do not care. Please be aware and help when you are able. It is a real service to the Lord.

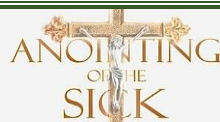
