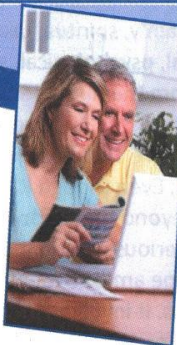

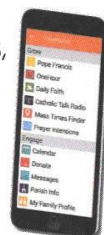
### WHY IS IT
