We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

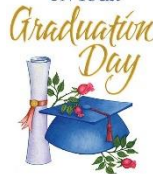

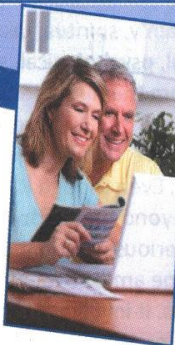

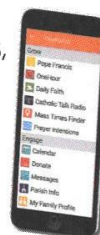
### WHY IS IT
