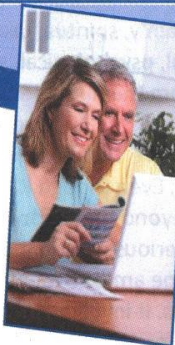

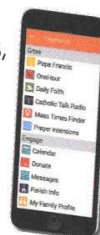
WHY IS IT
