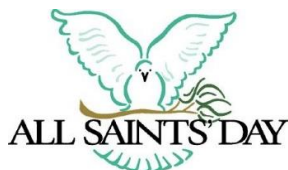


Looking for Altar Servers!!!

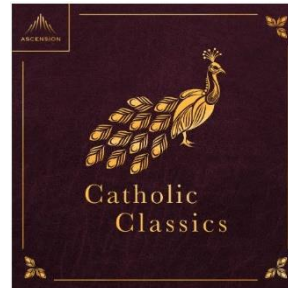

Qualifications for godparents are that they are practicing Catholics, registered in a parish, attending Mass regularly, baptized, confirmed, Holy Communion and if married, married in the Catholic Church. GODPARENTS SHOULD PROVIDE THEIR CATHOLIC CHURCH MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE AND CONFIRMATION CERTIFICATE. Godparents who live in another parish require a letter from their pastor recommending them as godparents.

Religious Education Registration

ALL youth are expected to be attending religious education. Registration forms and schedules for the new school year are available in the Narthex area. Classes have begun.

FIRST RECONCILIATION/FIRST COMMUNION - Children must be attending religious education classes the year before and the year of the sacrament. Children must be in at least the second grade the year of the sacrament.

CONFIRMATION PROGRAM-

The confirmation program is a two year program for high school students. The first year is a study of scripture, the second year studies the doctrine of our faith. The sacrament of confirmation is conferred the following October.

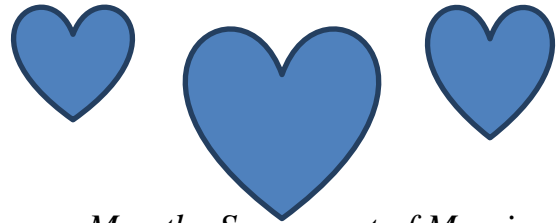

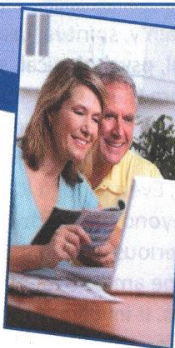

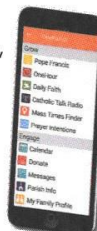
