

A young seminary student started the youth movement to come together for football and fun, and to





Deaconate Program

The Permanent Deaconate Program is a five-year program of study. The first year the men are called deacon aspirants, then after the Rite of Candidacy they are deacon candidates for the remaining four years. After the completion of all of their studies, and at the will of the bishop, they are ordained to the Permanent Diaconate. Currently our diocese has 7 men who are deacon aspirants. The increased demand for ministers in the Church, makes the work of the deacon more necessary today than it has been in past years.


