

Rice Bowls will be collected at the Holy Thursday Mass. Please be generous.



In Exodus in the Old Testament, 'An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth' was meant to limit punishment for crime to that which fits the crime. But Jesus challenges us to turn the other cheek and to love our enemies. This is not part of our instincts and is not easy. We get angry and when we are upset, we want to do or say something to express our pain and rage.


