



DISPENSATION FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF ABSTAINING FROM MEAT ON MARCH 17, 2023

During the holy season of Lent, we are asked by the Church to seriously take part in three pillars of charity - prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In particular on Fridays, the Church asks us to abstain from eating meat as an act of penance.

This Lent, the Feast of St. Patrick, patron of Ireland and Nigeria, falls on a Friday. Traditionally, there have been celebrations on this feast day in our Diocese of Jackson, including various cultural dishes with meat. Therefore, I have been asked to dispense from the requirement of abstaining from meat on Friday, March 17, 2023.

And so, I hereby grant this dispensation with the condition that those who take advantage of this dispensation will substitute another profound act of penance such as prayer and almsgiving to mark this day.




