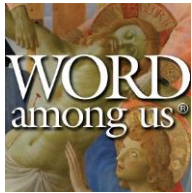

BUS DRIVER NEEDED

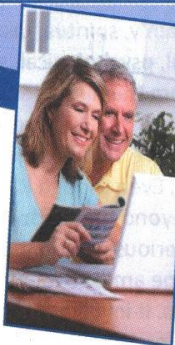

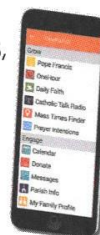
WHY IS IT
