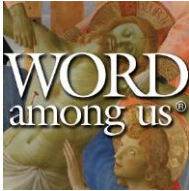


## Sacrament of the Sick

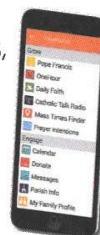
### WHY IS IT
