All Souls Triduum of Masses

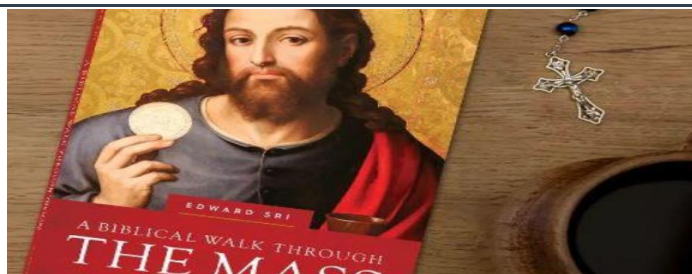
