

Dear Friends,

"Oh yes, I'm familiar with this Gospel... I've heard it over and over again. It applies to priests and

nuns, right? But I live in the real world, I have to work for a living!"

Whenever I have proclaimed this Gospel from Luke, as I glance across the congregation I can spot a glazed look on the faces of some, eyes closed on others. "This does not apply to me their body language says."

To be sure, the church can be held accountable for this line of thinking, since it has convinced lay people, "let us do the work, you can support us with financial help." Things have changed though. After Vatican II the work of involving lay people at least in the liturgy was like a giant semi trying to park in the main aisle of a small church... It still takes a lot of work, convincing people to take up liturgical roles.

The Good News remains the same, God continues to send EVERYONE out to be people of peace and goodwill, acknowledging that all we have and are comes from Him. To help usher in the Kingdom of God.

At the end of each Mass, we hear "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord, or Go forth, the Mass is ended or Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life. Go. Get going. Serve the Lord. Go on your way. Go...

#### **POPE LEO XIV**

# Pope Leo XIV echoes Pope Pius XII's historic appeal for peace.

In 1939, Pius XII issued his famous appeal by radio as the world stood on the brink of the Second World War. The Pope's words, which went unheard at the time, were echoed today by Leo XIV at the end of the General Audience, to call for peace in the face of the current climate of tension and violence.

"It is by the force of reason, not the force of arms, that justice makes its way," Pope Pius XII proclaimed. "Empires not founded on justice are not blessed by God. Politics divorced from morality betrays those who promote it."

He added, with urgency:

"The danger is imminent, but there is still time. Nothing is lost with peace. All may be lost with war. Let men return to mutual understanding. Let them resume negotiations. By negotiating with goodwill and respect for each other's rights, they will find that sincere and effective agreements are always possible—and can lead to bonourable success."
