

## FR. GUY'S REFLECTION



Dear Friends.

Have you noticed that in the Gospel of Luke, Jesus is frequently eating out, so to speak? Or He is at a dinner at which He feels the need to

teach and preach? At this particular dinner we are invited to observe Jesus (and the other folks at the table.) Just as they are carefully observing Him. I wonder if Jesus might've been tempted to say to the other guests, as they jockeyed for the best seats, "look at you, you look ridiculous! But that isn't the point.

All this talk about invitations to banquets, places of honor at the table, highest and lowest spots at the table, lunches and dinners, about rewriting your guest list, leads me to Jesus. Jesus spent His whole life centered on inviting into the presence of God those who neither expected, nor deserve such an invitation

I believe He expects us to do the same.

Of course, as with most of Jesus, parables, the meaning of the parable leads us out of the dining room, away from the plates of food to other places where we might not be sharing with others. Places we have shut out someone.

The table of the Eucharist, where I can invite anyone and everyone, where there are no seats of honor or secondary seats, a table of no restrictions where all are equal and welcome: the daily meal we served to the homeless and the poor. I have no doubt this is the table of the Lord's Eucharist, of His Body and Blood given to all. The utensils are plastic, the plates are paper or Styrofoam, no linen towels or linen table cloth (there is a plastic one though) but the presence of Jesus Christ is among us... Of this I am absolutely sure. As each plate of food is handed across the table, I am tempted to say "the Body of Christ"... And when I hear "thank you", that is the amen, which must please the Lord.




**TASTE OF DESOTO** – We need new items for these baskets. Also, if you have large baskets they can use them.
