



Dear Parishioners.

Last week I met with a local stain glass artisan with the intention of repairing some of our windows. Most of the windows are in good shape, but some of the lower windows, which open and close, have cracks, and there are two which actually have small breaks. I am hoping the windows can be repaired before the cold weather comes. The windows at Most Precious Blood are one of the most beautiful aspects of the Church, and in fact there is a pattern to their placement. When facing the altar, looking to the left, the first window recounts the Apparitions of the Blessed Mother at Lourdes. The next window is the Annunciation, the first decade of the Joyful mysteries: and that sets the pattern. First the Joyful, then Sorrowful and finally the Glorious mysteries are depicted in the windows. The last window on the right – recounts the Crowning of Mary, the final decade of the Glorious mysteries. The window in the Choir loft includes beautiful symbols of the Blessed Trinity.

Some of the windows have interesting details. i.e. Recently I read a book called: Jesus: A Pilgrimage. It recounts the pilgrimage of Fr. James Martin S.J. to the Holy Land. In his travel log, he writes: "One of the places Ignatius (of Loyola) longed to see was this spot, particularly to venerate the stone on which Jesus was standing before the Ascension – and where, legend had it, he left behind two footprints." Well, after reading that, it resolved a question I had about the window in our church which depicts the Ascension of our Lord, because sure enough, on the stone below his feet, is the depiction of the two footprints, which were left behind.


