

Note from Fr. Bill:

I plan to make a pilgrimage to Fatima and southern Spain from Monday February 11 to Wednesday February 20, returning late that day. I'll be going with Cardinal Dolan and a group of priests from the Archdiocese of New York. I signed up for this pilgrimage back in November, long before I knew about being named a bishop and departing from MPB at the end of February. In spite of the difficult timing so soon before my departure from the parish on February 28, I decided to go through with the pilgrimage because I've never visited Fatima, and this may be my last opportunity for some extended time with my brother priests from the Archdiocese of New York.

Fr. Josepe of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal (C.F.R.) will offer 9:00 a.m. Mass on Tuesday and Wednesday, 12-13 February and all the Saturday evening – Sunday Masses on February 16-17. Fr. John Vondras will offer 9:00am Mass on Friday and Saturday February 15-16, and Monday-Wednesday February 18-20. Thank you for welcoming them and helping them with everything they need.

I have an update on my future assignment with the Archdiocese for the Military Services (AMS): Archbishop Broglio has assigned me to the Europe-Asia vicariate of AMS. I will live in Germany (not on a military base) and travel extensively throughout Europe and Asia, visiting U.S. Military bases from all branches of the armed forces and possibly U.S. embassies, visiting and shepherding priest chaplains, offering Mass for military communities (and possibly also for diplomatic communities), and confirming adults and teenagers. I'm delighted with this prospect and am sure that I will learn to adapt to the many challenges it will present. I know the Lord is calling me to serve the Church in this particular way. But—as always—I ask for your continued prayers and assure you of my own. God bless you!


