## **SACRAMENT OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK:**

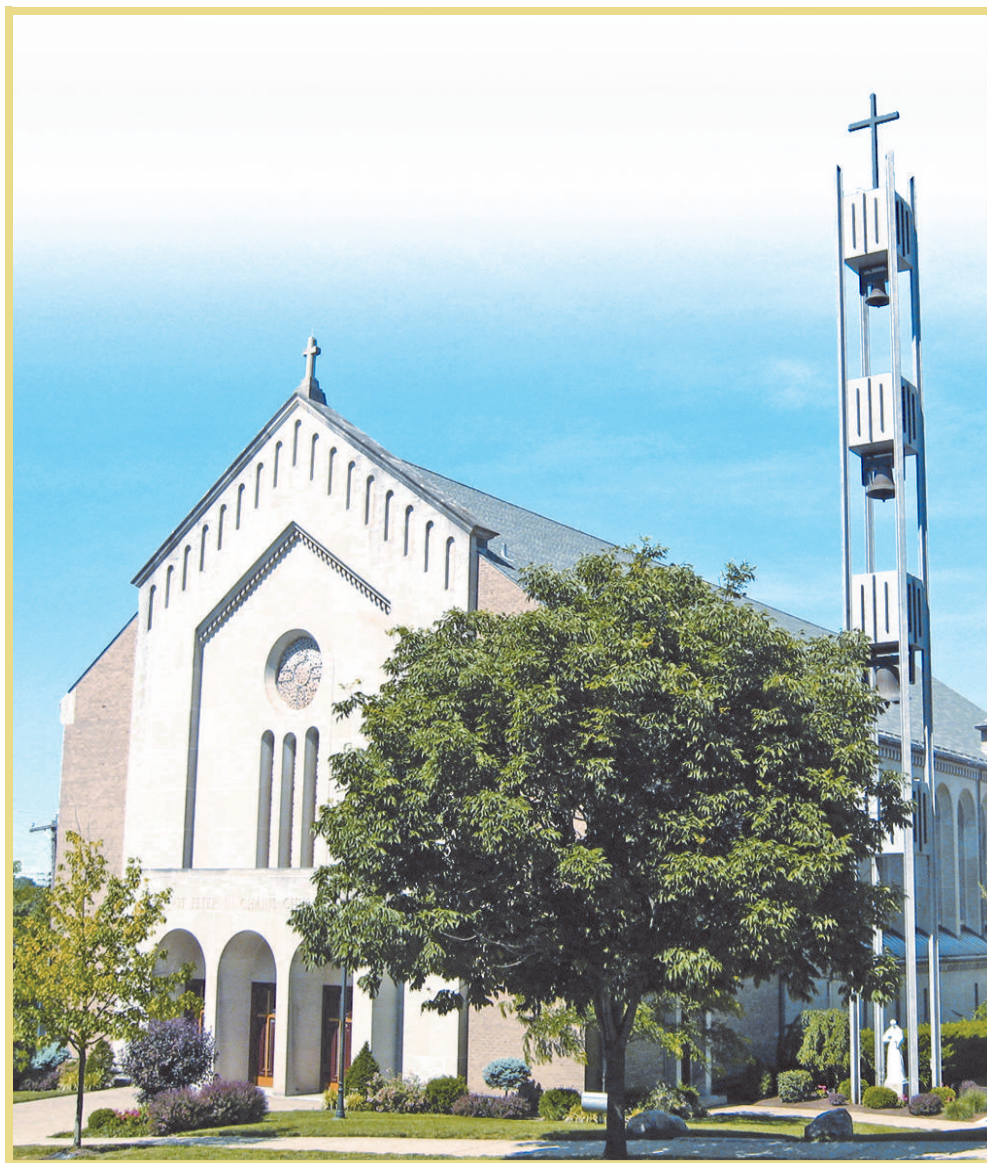
A communal celebration of the Sacrament is celebrated annually in October at one of the Sunday Masses. Individuals may request the Sacrament any time by calling the church office.

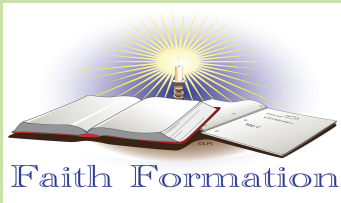

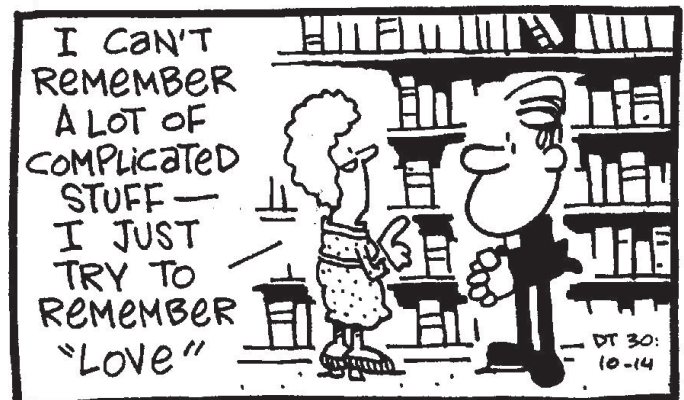
