Focus on Saints—St. Peter Claver (1580-1654) was a Spanish Jesuit priest who was dedicated to the salvation of African slaves and to the abolition of slavery during his 33 years of his ministry in Cartagena, a port city on the Caribbean coast of Columbia in the New World. Through his efforts, 300,000 slaves converted to Catholicism during their

incarceration. Peter Claver was canonized in 1888, and Pope Leo XIII declared him the worldwide patron of missionary work among black slaves.

Shepherd's Call

Beginning this month, our pastoral region is implementing a new program for parents preparing to have a child baptized. One reason is to make the process uniform across the three parishes of the region. That will allow more effective use of time for the volunteers and for the clergy who assist in the process. It also allows me to have equal confidence in all three parishes. The primary reason, though, is that many Catholics stop practicing the faith during their teenage years. Because of this, they are very unprepared to fulfill the roles of Christian parents or godparents. One of my seminary professors once said that in the spiritual life, there is no standing still. A 16-year old should have a more mature faith than a 10-year old; a 26-year old a more mature faith than a 16-year old. If you're not moving forward, then you're falling behind. Therefore, those who have been away from the Church have the faith of a 14-year old, but the responsibilities of a 30-year old. As a pastor, I have a responsibility to try to fill that gap as far as I am able, for the benefit of the child to be baptized and for the benefit of the parents or potential Godparents.

Fr. Djekoe has assisted me in looking at our baptismal preparation process. Our goal is to help parents and godparents think about their faith and express their faith in terms of friendship with God. It's easy to understand that a friendship should grow over time. Friendship is also something they would want to share and very naturally share with their children. An authentic friendship isn't just about getting benefits; it's about sharing one's life and the stuff of one's life.

A couple desiring to have their child baptized would attend an initial meeting with me, Fr. Richmond, or a baptism coordinator. At the initial meeting, godparents receive forms to present at their own parish. After the initial meeting, the parents attend two classes a month apart. Parents are strongly encouraged to begin preparation during the pregnancy because the classes are offered at set times and because life is a little more chaotic after the child is born.

The National Pilgrim Statue Tour

The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima presently travels across the United States under the sponsorship of the World Apostolate of Fatima USA (WAF), and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati is blessed to host a tour of the statue from Friday, September 8 through Thursday, September 28, 2017. Our parish region is personally honored and privileged to host the statue on

Tuesday, September 19 at St. Julie, beginning at 5:00 pm.

The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue is a beautiful hand-carved image of Our Lady of Fatima given to the United States by the bishop of Fatima after being blessed by Pope Paul VI in 1967. The statue was crowned by Cardinal O'Boyle at the National Basilica in Washington, DC in 1971, and the statue has proven time and again to be the catalyst for renewed interest in the message of Fatima and for exposing new generations of Catholics, who are unaware of the important message of conversion and peace brought by Our Lady to the three shepherd children in 1917 at Fatima, Portugal.

September "Make a Change" Archdiocesan Respect Life Fund

In 1973, on the recommendation of the Archdiocesan Pastoral Council, an annual collection was established to provide financial support to over 100 lifegiving and life-sustaining organizations located within 19 counties of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. The collection is held in October in our Catholic parishes. All monies collected are forwarded to the Chancery Office and designated for the Respect-Life Collection. A portion of these funds assist in sustaining the Respect Life programs of the archdiocese. The balance is designated for Respect-Life Grants. Applications are evaluated by the Respect-Life Grant Committee, facilitated by the Director of the Family and Respect Life Office. Recommendations are provided to the Archbishop for his final approval. Funds are disbursed in January of the following year.


