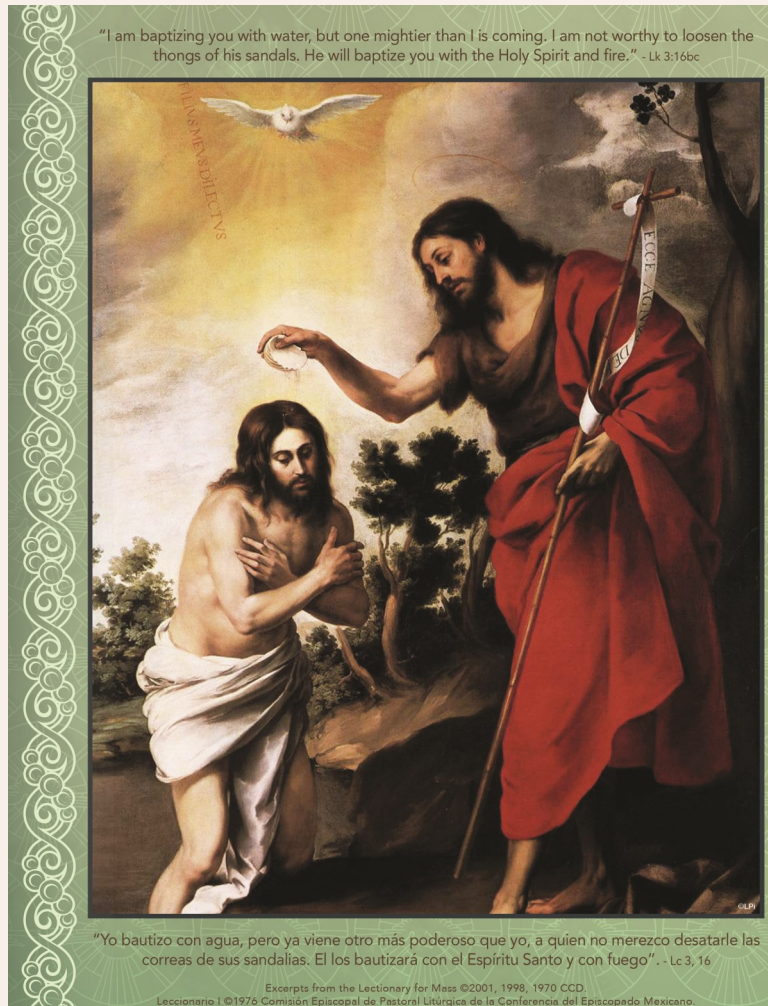

Shepherd's Call

This weekend we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord. When Jesus was baptized, both John the Baptist and the voice from the heavens testified to his identity as Messiah and Son of God. It also marked the beginning of his public ministry and mission to redeem our fallen world. In the homily Fr. Richmond and I reflect on the share in his mission that each of us received at our baptism. That's right, every one of the baptized – and not just priests and nuns – have a share in Christ's mission. Whether it is a nation, a family, a company, or the Church, a group is only as strong as its members. 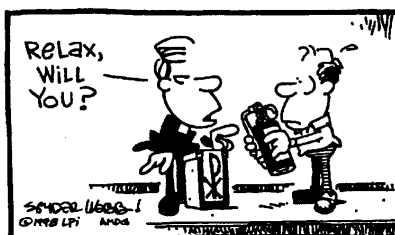
